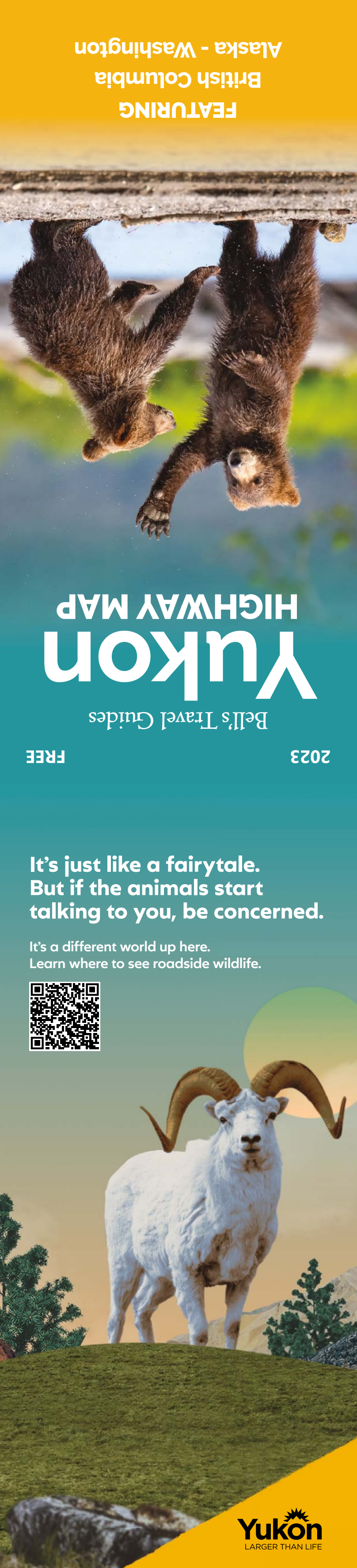

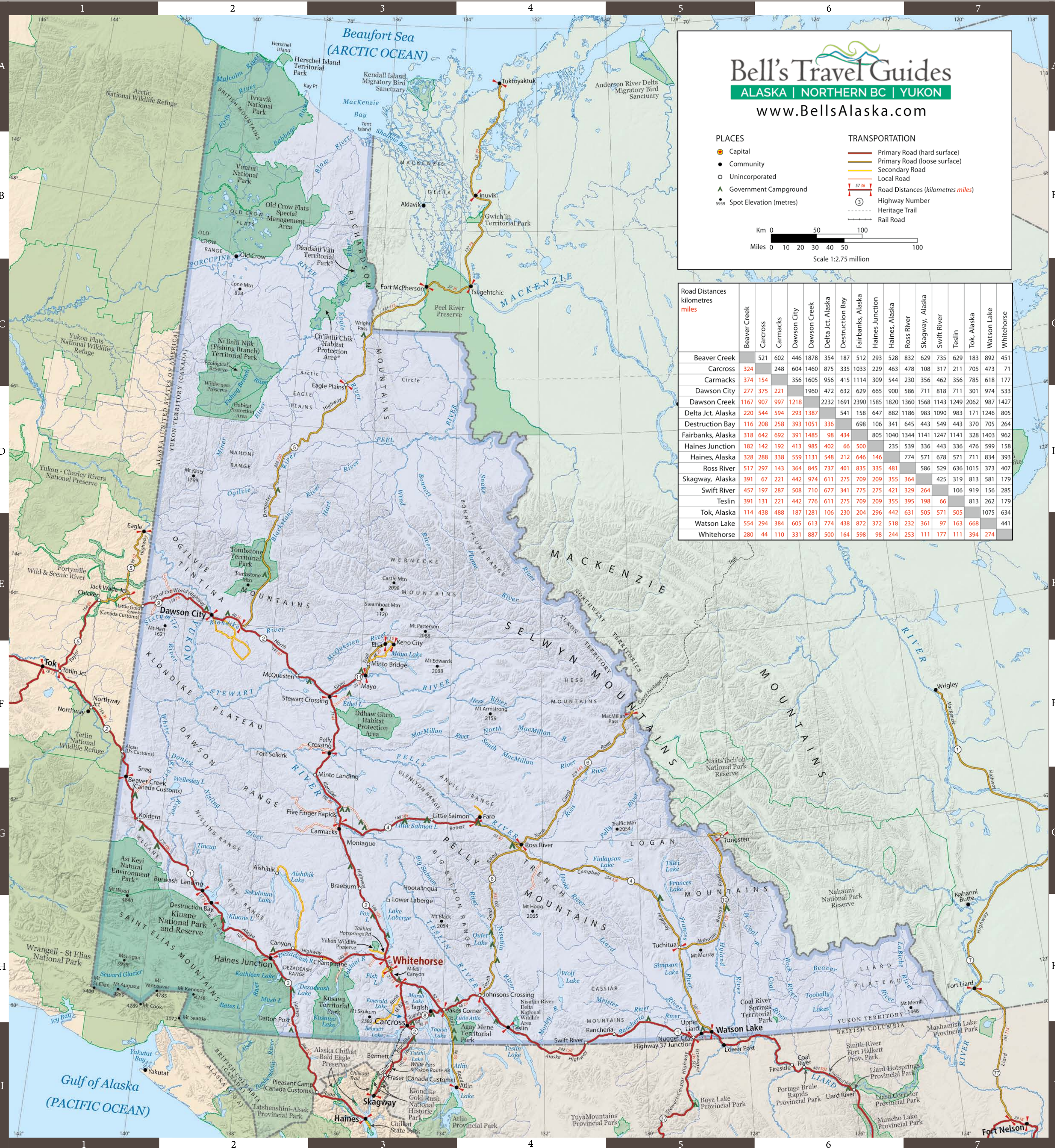

3 key tips for road trips

- 1. SUPPLIES**
You may have to travel long distances between gas stations and food stops, so fill 'er up and stock up on snacks when you can. No hangry driving, please.
- 2. WILDLIFE**
Watch out for four-legged locals on or near the road, particularly around dawn and dusk. Keep your distance and avoid lingering.
- 3. NAVIGATION**
No cell service in some locations means, "goodbye Google Maps." Keep a compass handy and use this map to mark your routes.
